## The numbers tell the story:

- Supportive relationships between children and teachers is fundamental to the healthy development of all children. Schonert-Reichl (2007)
- "Strong and supportive relationships between teachers and students are fundamental to the **healthy development** of all students in schools." Hamre and Pianta (2006)
- Children who are engaged in school-related activities, such as band or athletics, are more likely to feel connected to school and have higher academic achievement, and less likely to engage in risky behaviors (such as alcohol and drug use) and eventually dropout of school. Eccles and Barber (1999)
- **29% of BC kindergarten children are vulnerable.** If we reduce early vulnerability to 10% we will have a **31% reduction in crime.** Kershaw, Anderson, Warburton, & Hertzman, (2009)

→The math is simple: we need to invest in our children.
